

Data Privacy Statement

The company Hamlitsch GmbH & Co KG, Wirtschaftspark 28, 8530 Deutschlandsberg, collects, processes and uses personal data gathered from customers and suppliers only, if their explicit consent has been obtained for the agreed purposes, or if another legal basis in accordance with the GDPR exists in compliance with the applicable statutory provisions governed by the data protection and civil law.

We shall only collect such personal data which are required for the performance and handling of our services, or which are voluntarily made available to us by customers and suppliers.

The company Hamlitsch GmbH & Co KG processes the following data:

- First name, surname, title, company, VAT ID, address
- A statement on the entitlement to the purchase of alcoholic beverages
- ip addresses, password
- contact data (email address, phone number)
- data on orders and/or deliveries
- bank details and/or data on payments
- any enquiries submitted via the contact form
- other data made available voluntarily

Processing of data

The company Hamlitsch GmbH & Co KG shall process the data indicated above for the handling of orders placed by customers and/or suppliers as well as marketing measures. For this purpose, the necessary data shall be submitted to postal service and shipping companies, forwarding agencies and haulage companies, loading stations, payment service providers, banks, where necessary, to debt collection companies, employees and members of staff, IT service providers, tax consultants, and, in case of data received from suppliers, to certification authorities.

Erasure of data

The company Hamlitsch GmbH & Co KG shall erase the data provided by customers and suppliers as well as any other personal data after the termination of the contractual relationship and after expiry of all statutory storage obligations and retention requirements; however, in respect of marketing measures, only after the customer's request has been received by us.

Cookies

The website www.hamlitsch.at makes use of so-called cookies. Cookies are text files which are placed on the client server and stored by the browser. They serve the purpose of making our offer more user-friendly, more effective and safer. Cookies further enable our online shop to identify the browser and to offer you related services. Cookies do not contain any personal data.

Customers and suppliers may assert the following rights with regard to the processing of their data:

Right of access to information:

Customers and suppliers have the right to obtain a confirmation as to whether and to which extent data are processed.

Right to erasure

Customers and suppliers shall have the right to obtain the erasure of their personal data, if the same are processed unlawfully or where the processing impinges disproportionately on their justified protective interests. Statutory storage obligations and other reasons may be in conflict with an immediate erasure.

Right to rectification

Where personal data are processed, which are incomplete or incorrect, customers and suppliers may demand their rectification and/or completion at any time.

Right to restriction of processing

Customers and suppliers may demand the restriction of the processing with regard to their data, if

- the accuracy of the data is contested, for a period enabling our company to verify the accuracy of the personal data,
- the processing of the data is unlawfully, and where they request the restriction of the use of data instead of their erasure,
- if the data are no longer needed for the intended purpose, but where the same data are still required for the establishment or defence of legal claims or
- an objection was lodged against the processing of the data.

Right to data portability

Customers and suppliers have the right to receive their data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, if these data are processed as a result of a given and revocable consent or for the purpose of a contractual performance and this processing is carried out by automated means.

Right to object

Customers and suppliers shall have the right to file an objection against the processing of data.

The right to lodge a complaint

Should the processing of the data violate the data protection law, the company Hamlitsch GmbH & Co KG requests you to contact us directly in order to clarify the issue and circumstances. Customers and suppliers are entitled to lodge a complaint with the Austrian Data Protection Authority.
